District Governor Dan Semenza





Dan Semenza joined the Rotary Club of the Villages in June of 1997. He served as Club President 2001-2002. From the time he entered Rotary, he has chaired or was a member of every committee in the club and received the Avenues of Service Award in 2012. In 2013, he was awarded the Rotarian of the Year award.

At the District level, Dan served as an Assistant Governor for four years, chaired the Service Project Committee, was a member of both the District Foundation Committee, and Membership Committee. He graduated from the Rotary Leadership Institute in 2007 and became a discussion leader. He became the Director of the District Leadership Institute in 2013. A YEO is a Rotarian who would be the contact person at the club for their exchange student and the Youth Exchange District Committee. The position of a YEO is simple and takes very little time. It requires the following:

- updating the club on Youth Exchange events
