

JOHN PIERSON LANDGRAF, age 76, of Orlando, passed away February 8, 2018. He was born December 29, 1941 in Indianapolis, Indiana to Mayburn and Mary Alice (Polly) Landgraf. John was a graduate of Indiana University and a veteran of the U.S. Navy.

He was a member of First Baptist Church Windermere, and a former member of the Rotary Club of Windermere where he was active in the West Orlando High School Interact Club sponsored by the Rotarians.

John enjoyed the theatre and was in several plays at the Edyth Bush Civic Theatre.

John spent his working career in the bank marketing business. His employment and positions included VP and Director of Research and Market Planning for Sun Banks of Florida, Director of Marketing for United Banks of Colorado in Denver, and Staff Manager for the National Financial Institution Consulting Practice of KPMG Peat Marwick based in Atlanta.

John started his own business, Landgraf Marketing Services, when he and his family returned to Orlando. Upon retiring, John was a substitute teacher at West Orange High School and Olympia High School. John is survived by his wife Mary, daughter Kim Landgraf Cooke (Rob), and grandson Hunter Pierson Cooke.
