He received his MA at Rollins College, then his PhD from the University of Florida. He began his career as a teacher at Maynard Evans High School. He became Principal at Tildenville Elementary School then at Hiawassee Elementary School. Later he joined the OCPS District Administrative Office as Administrative Assistant to the Superintendent and ended up as the Superintendent from 1990 to 1997. He also was an Adjunct Instructor at both University of Florida and University of Central Florida. He was awarded the Florida Superintendent of the Year in 1997.

Married since 1962 to Susan Daniels, they have two daughters, 4 grand-children & 6 great grandchildren. Interesting, Susan, two of their daughters and two of their grandchildren all taught at Windermere Elementary & one great grandchild is a kindergartener there now.

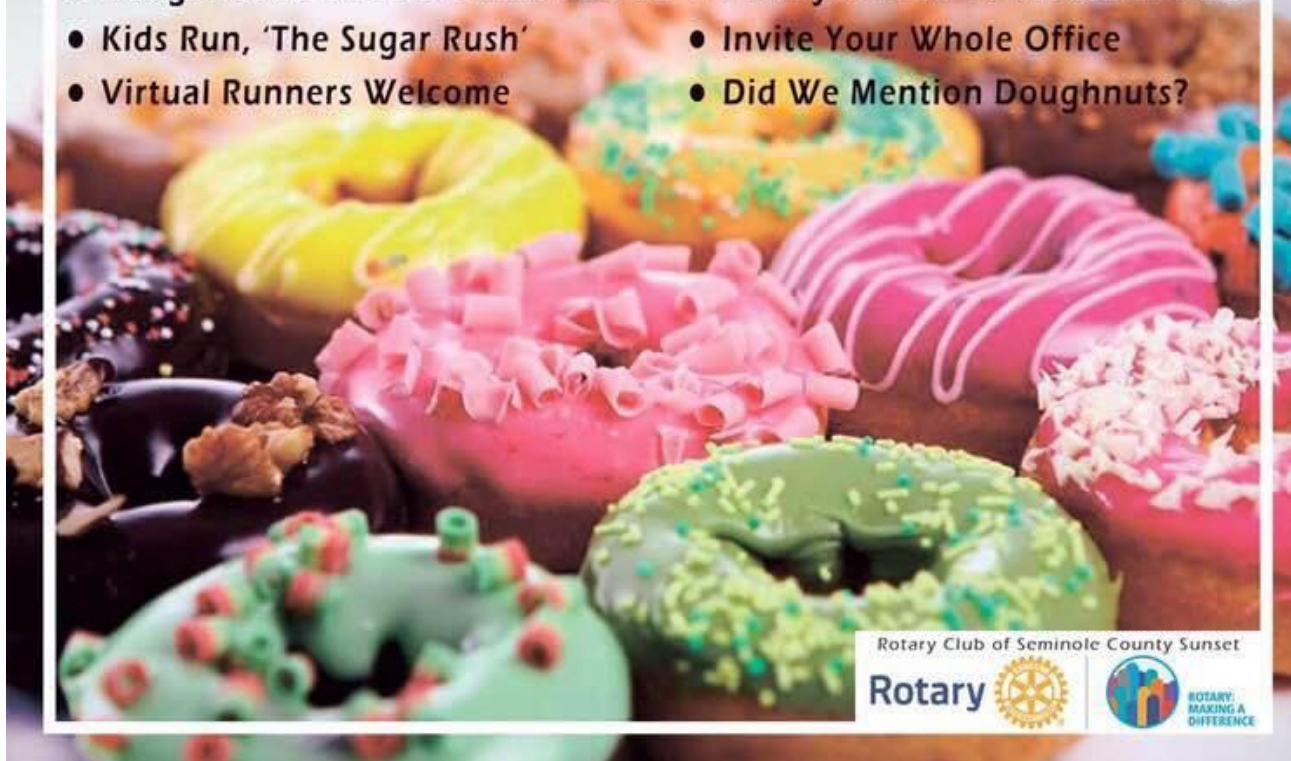
