TO JOIN US AT THE V.A. HOSPITAL IN LAKE NONA

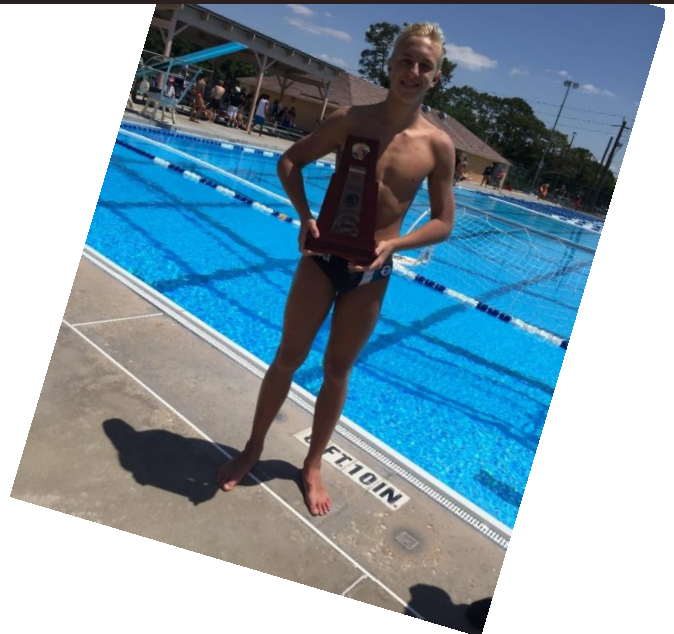
We will be playing bingo with the soldiers starting at 2 pm.
