Rotary Club of Windermere – Boating Committee Report*



The Windermere Rotary Boating Committee (WRBC, pronounced “we’re back”) issues its first after action report. On Friday, June 15, 2018, fellow charter WRBC members and storm hunters, Mike Magill and Frank Krens ran the first in a series of extreme weather boating trials. In the face of severe storm warnings from multiple news sources, concerned family members, and like, the sky, captain and crew pressed on - demonstrating proficiency in severe weather boating challenges including:

- staying afloat in 4-foot waves and swells
- navigating in zero visibility conditions
- station-keeping in 30+ mile per hour winds
- fixed hazard avoidance
- lightning strike avoidance
- cell phone coms maintenance/wife and daughter calming.

WRBC will take on further challenges as they arise:

- repelling boarders
- avoiding mutiny
- fending off pirates of the Butler Chain.

Join us on our next adventure – planned, unplanned, spontaneous. Regardless of what Frank’s wife says, we’re not as crazy as we look.
