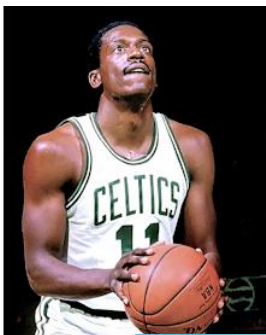

**Sam Vincent  
Basketball Star  
Founder of  
AAU Global Coach Academy**



**Sam Vincent was born in Lansing, Michigan. He attended Lansing Eastern High and Michigan State University. In 1981 they were the High School State Champions and he had the schools single game record score of 61 points. Sam was Michigan’s 1<sup>st</sup> Mr. Basketball. He was on the McDonald’s All -American team, the USA collegiate All-American team and the first round draft pick to the Boston Celtics. Following his basketball playing career, Sam became the Head Coach for the MBA D League Champions, the Mobile Revelers. He also was the Head Coach for the FIBA Africa Championship, the Nigeria Olympic team, the Assistant coach for the Dallas Mavericks, the Charlotte Bobcats and the Al Manama Bahrain league who took 1<sup>st</sup> place in the Bahrain Super Cup Championship. In 2016 Sam launched Jr. NBA Bahrain. In 2017 he became the head coach for FIBA AFRO Basket Champion Nigeria. He is currently the Director of the NBA *Basketball Without Borders* in Africa & Founder of the AAU Global Coach Academy.**

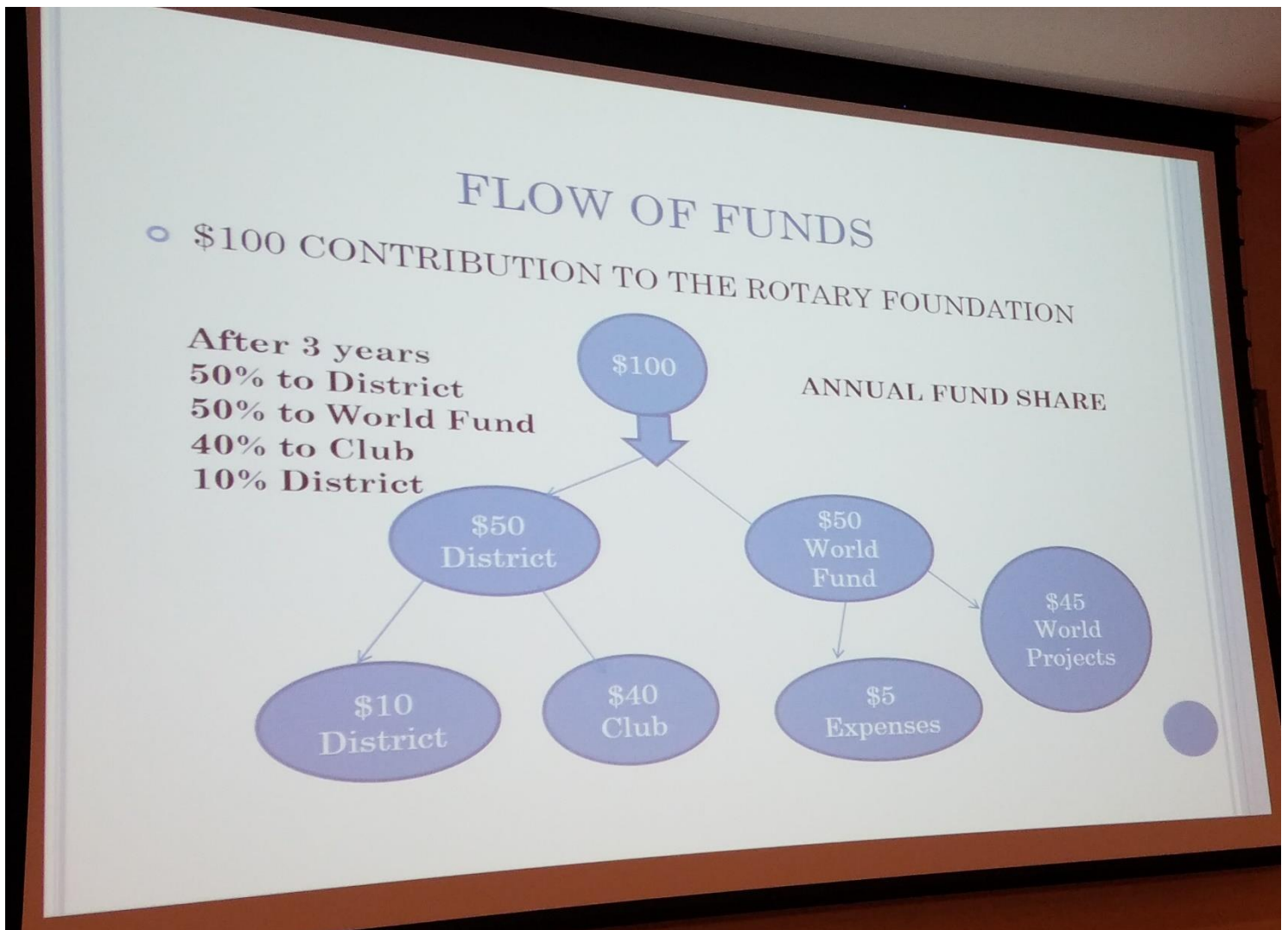
