

According to the District's Standard Operating procedures Manual and according to RIB 13.020.8, beginning today, for the next 14 days clubs may submit a qualified challenge. If no qualified challenges are submitted within the net 14 days, Barry will become the District Governor Nominee Designate on Saturday October 27, 2018.

Hurricane Fund

Rotary's role in disaster relief has increased dramatically in recent year, now often working side by side with FEMA and the Red Cross. Those most impacted by hurricanes last year were the first to reach out and help our fellow Rotarians and Floridians. Seeing the wake of Michael's destruction in the Panhandle, it is time for us to help out as well.

My counterpart in District 6940, District Governor John Medina, is coordinating Rotary's response. I asked him what was most needed. He said FEMA has done a great job of bringing in generators and chain saws, but unfortunately the fuel to run them is sorely lacking. I talked with AG Edwin Wright who owns a fuel company. He is trying to arrange for a truck to bring fuel in from Louisiana or Alabama. We will need over \$16,000 to pay for the fuel alone so that is our goal. I am asking each of you to go to your club to help raise the money. I will talk with District Treasurer Tom Meena tomorrow about the best way to consolidate it. For now, let's at least begin getting it collected at the club level. Avron Satill, the district Disaster Relief Chair is out of town, but will be back in Florida on Tuesday and will take command of our efforts then.

Thank you in advance for all of your help. You never know, we could be next. It's time to help our friends.

We will also celebrate **World Polio Day** during the evening.

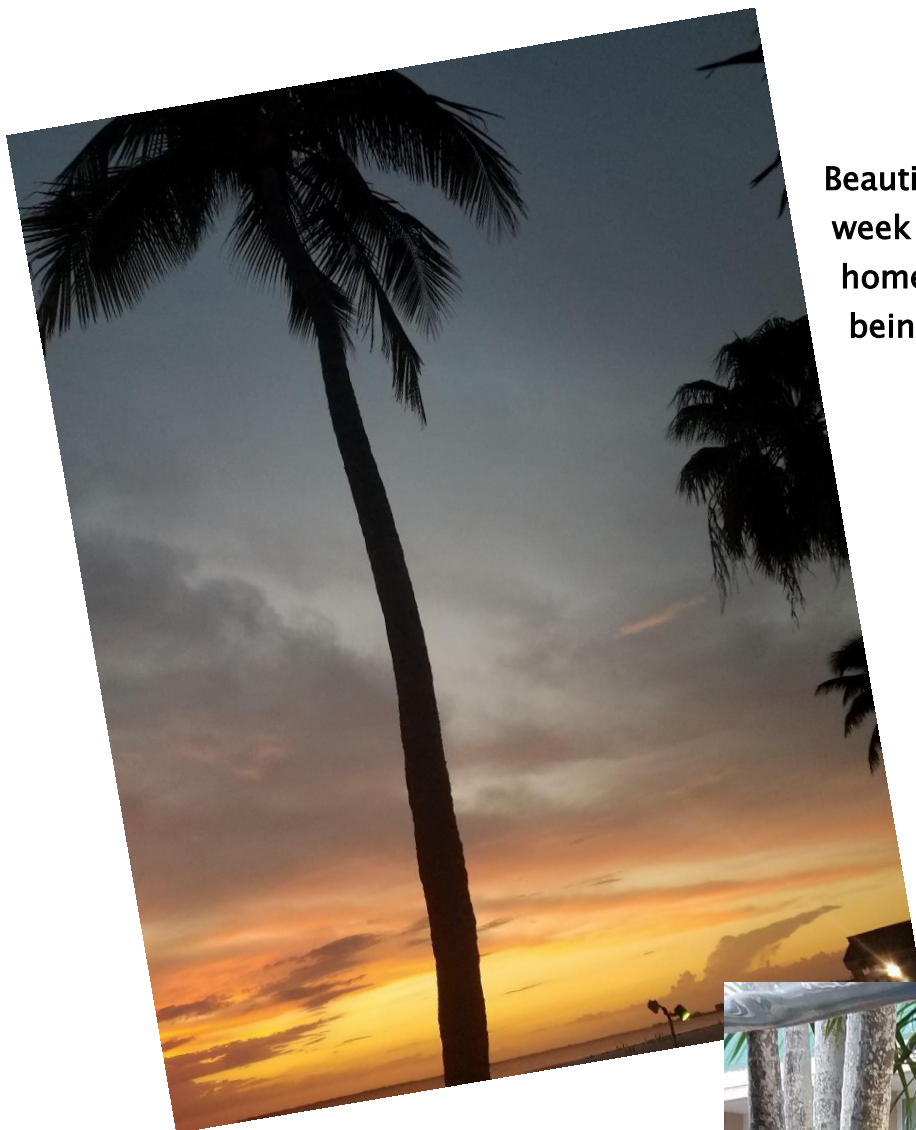
