





Preparations for World Polio Day are in full swing: partners and stakeholders across the world are preparing for **World Polio Day on 24 October**, to raise awareness and resources for the global eradication effort. • Summary of newly-reported viruses this week: Afghanistan – one case of wild poliovirus type 1 (WPV1) and five WPV1-positive environmental samples; Pakistan – seven WPV1-positive environmental samples; Nigeria – three cases of circulating vaccine-derived poliovirus type 2 (cVDPV2); and Horn of Africa (Somalia) – one cVDPV type 3-positive environmental sample.
