A Rotarian since 1978 with 40 years of perfect attendance, **Charlie** has served RI as a President’s Representative, Council on Legislation Representative, Rotary International Training Leader, RI Convention Senior SAA, RI Major Gifts Advisor, RI Membership Zone Coordinator, and District Governor in 2000-01. He is a recipient of Rotary International’s “Service Above Self Award” and The Rotary Foundation’s “Citation for Meritorious Service” and “The Distinguished Service Award”. Charlie and his wife Mary are Major Donors, Bequest Society Members and Paul Harris Society Members of The Rotary Foundation and he has served on the RI Open World Advisory Group since 2006.

Charlie serves as the Chief Executive Officer of the Early Learning Coalition of Osceola County, after retiring from a 34-year career in banking. He served on the Florida Division Board of Directors for the American Cancer Society and was appointed by both Governor Bush and Governor Crist to chair the Early Learning Coalition of Osceola County from 2005-2015. Charlie currently serves on the Board of Directors for the Boy Scouts of America, Central Florida Cares Health System, Community Vision, the Education Foundation of Osceola County, Junior Achievement, the Kissimmee/Osceola Chamber of Commerce, and the Valencia College Foundation as well as serving as the Chairman for the Business Advisory Board of the Osceola County School District.

Charlie and his wife Mary, who is also a Rotarian and works for Walt Disney World, have two married children - Katie (30) who is a certified mental health counselor and Andrew (28), who served in the US Navy’s nuclear program and is now a Transmission Operator for First Energy in Canton, Ohio.



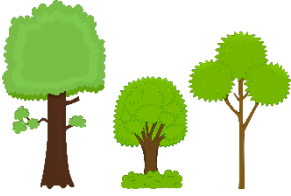
