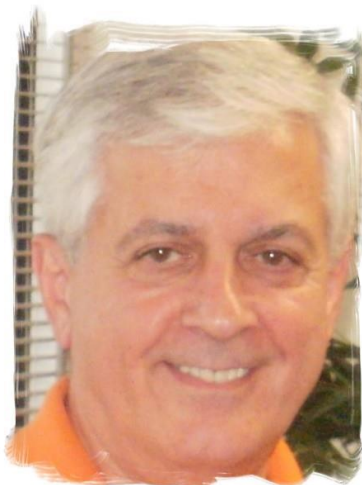

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

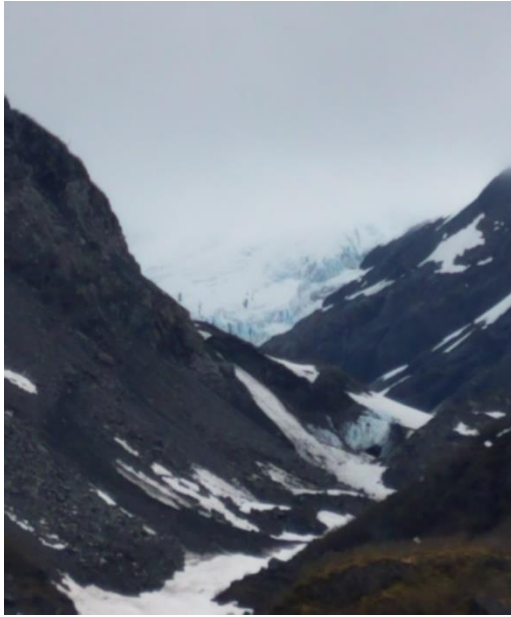

Serving as co-chair of the Central Florida Foundation's 100 Women Strong allows Desai to fulfill one of her passions: helping women and children. 100 Women Strong is a female-only, venture capitalist-based giving circle that focuses on solving community-based problems specific to women and children by using data analytics and big data. As co-chair, Desai has helped grow the program from about 20 members to more than 100. Last year she was promoted to president at Schellman & Company, making her the only female minority of a top 100 CPA firm. She is also founding member of the Orlando Tech Association, where she focuses on closing the gender gap for women in information technology, and she is a board member for the Arnold Palmer Hospital Foundation.
