

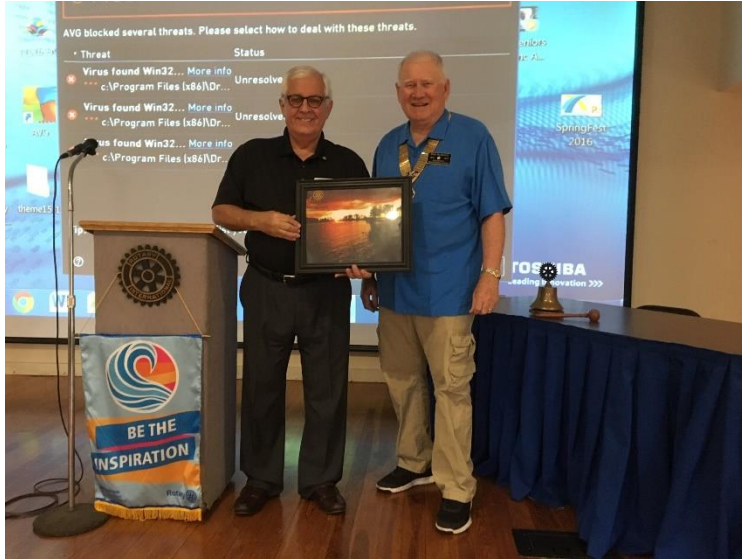

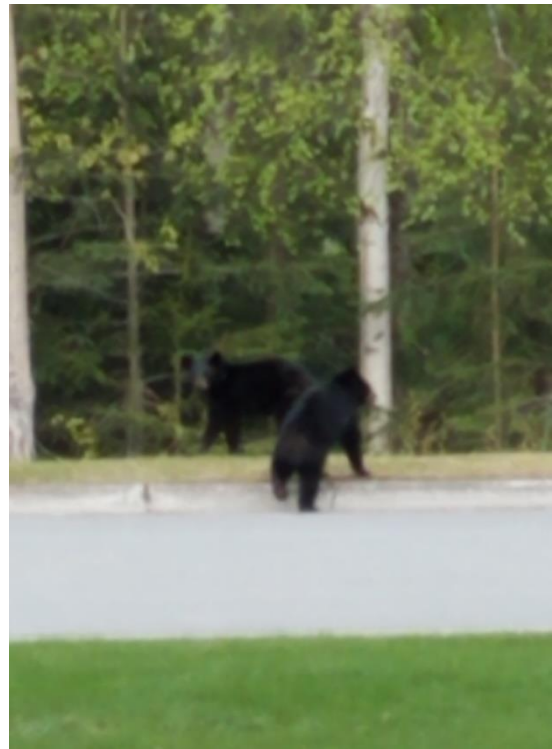


Norma & Byron from Alaska
