Steve has 34+ years’ experience in the operation and maintenance of domestic wastewater treatment facilities.

29+ years’ experience in the operation and maintenance of reclaimed water transmission and distribution facilities and rapid infiltration basin systems.

He taught “Water Conserv II and Its Contribution to Water Conservation” at the Certified Crop Advisors Seminar at the South Florida Citrus Center in Clearwater, October 22, 2003. 
