Jennifer Gardiner, PhD.
Biomedical Engineer



Jennifer Gardiner will be sharing her experience working at the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation in Seattle, WA. Until recently, Jennifer was working as a Senior Program Officer in Global Health at the Gates Foundation. In this role, she was responsible for making and managing grants to partner organizations, typically universities, pharmaceutical, and diagnostic companies. Her primary focus was to develop better ways to diagnose tuberculosis, understand the burden of infectious diseases in low income countries, and understand what causes preterm birth.

She previously worked as a Research Scientist at two pharmaceutical companies, Wyeth and Johnson & Johnson, in the Philadelphia area.

Jennifer earned her Bachelor's degree at Duke University and PhD in Biological Engineering at MIT. She recently relocated back to Windermere with her husband and three young children.


