Byron Sutton incorporated World Trade Center Orlando in 1990. The World Trade Center Orlando is a not for profit, private, membership based organization that is affiliated worldwide with the World Trade Centers Association. With offices in 338 cities in 103 countries and over one million member companies worldwide, the WTC offers full service to companies wanting to enter the international market.

Byron was born in Loogootee, Indiana and graduated from Indiana University with a B.A. Economics. He also attended Indiana University School of Law before serving in the US Air Force and Air Force Reserve for over 30 years. He retired as a Lt. Col. in 1991 as a Command Pilot and served in both Viet Nam and the Gulf War. He is a graduate of the Air Force Squadron Officers, Command and Staff and Air War College. He received the Silver Star for Valor, the Distinguished Flying Cross with three oak leaf clusters, the Air Force Cross, Bronze Star and Air Medal with 21 oak leaf clusters. He also spent spent 20 years with Northwest Airlines as both a domestic and international pilot. Mr. Sutton traveled and has been in business in the international arena for the past thirty years.





A conversation with Lt General Jay Garner (Ret)



In 2003 Gen Garner was selected to lead the post-war reconstruction efforts in Iraq, along with three deputies, including British Major-General Tim Cross. Garner was regarded as a natural choice by the Bush administration given his earlier experience in the region including serving as the allied commander of Operation Provide Comfort; the multi-national mission to protect the Kurds in Northern Iraq following the first Gulf War. General Garner was to develop and implement plans to assist the Iraqis in developing governance and reconstructing the country once Saddam Hussein was deposed. Jay is currently an active defense and energy industry consultant and travels to the Middle East and the Kurdish region of Iraq several times a year.
