



The biggest vaccination campaign in history has begun. More than **12.3 million doses** in 30 countries have been administered, according to data collected by Bloomberg. Delivering billions more will be one of the greatest logistical challenges ever undertaken.

Vaccinations in the U.S. began Dec. 14 with health-care workers, and so far **4.33 million doses** have been given, according to a state-by-state tally by Bloomberg and data from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

Vaccines Across America

Across the U.S., 1.3% of the population has been vaccinated and 33% of the shots distributed to states have been administered. The U.S. is managing state allocations of <u>Pfizer and BioNTech's vaccine</u>, as well as <u>Moderna's shot</u>, with the goal of getting 20 million doses distributed by early January. Both vaccines require two doses taken several weeks apart. The second doses are being held in reserve until they're ready to be administered.

BIG NEWS!!! Major League Soccer unveils The 25 Greatest presented by AT&T

The most decorated and impactful players in MLS history honored as part of 25th Season celebration

NEW YORK (December 9, 2020) – As part of the continued celebration of its 25th season, Major League Soccer today announced The 25 Greatest presented by AT&T – honoring the 25 brightest stars in league history.

A special panel of nearly 200 MLS experts from across North America was brought together to select the 25 players who achieved the most on the field, drove the narrative off the field, and helped lay the foundation and set the course for MLS's next 25 years.

Major League Soccer nominated 137 of the most decorated and impactful players in league history. The nomination committee looked for players who accomplished one or more of the following as an MLS player:

- Received multiple league-wide individual honors such as: Best XI, Most Valuable Player, Golden Boot, Defender/Goalkeeper of the Year, All-Star selections
- Won major team trophies such as: MLS Cup, Supporters' Shield, U.S. Open Cup, international club competitions

In all, nine different nationalities are represented in The 25 Greatest. The 25 players appeared for 20 different MLS clubs over their careers. Of the 25 players, three players as goalkeepers, five were defenders, nine primarily played as midfielders, and eight were predominantly forwards.

The voting panel was comprised of four groups: MLS Greats & Emeritus (former players, coaches, staff), current MLS Club staff, Media Members and Broadcast Partners (local and national). MLS invited panelists based on years of experience within MLS, geographic balance, and game expertise.

D.C. United: 1996-2000; San Jose Earthquakes: 2001-2004; MetroStars: 2005 A three-time honoree in the MLS Best XI and a member of the MLS All-Time Best XI (2005). Winner of the MLS Defender of the Year award in 2001. Five-time winner of MLS Cup, second-most in league history. Also won the Supporters' Shield (twice), U.S. Open Cup, CONCACAF Champions Cup, and Copa Interamericana. A 9-time MLS All-Star selection.
