Mr. Howard has ten years of experience in the recycling industry. Throughout his career, he served several recycling facilities located in the Southeastern part of the United States, as operator, supervisor, manager and executive. Prior to joining Waste Pro, he served as the Plant Manager of the Onslow County Material Recovery Facility (MRF) in Jacksonville, North Carolina. One of Will’s many accomplishments in this position, was certifying the facility through the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) and winning the Safety and Health Award Recognition Program (SHARP). At the time this exclusive award had only been given to 108 businesses out of over 36,000 in the state of North Carolina. Also, in this position, he received two municipal awards for excellence, the Robert L. Frank Award and the James R. Strickland Award for his community outreach and efforts towards sustainability. Will also collaborated with CP Manufacturing, a recycling manufacturer based out of California, on building and testing the first generation of a sorting system known as the McMRF. Will joined Waste Pro in July 2015 as the Production Manager of the Ocala, Florida MRF. Most recently Will was named one of Waste360’s 2020 top 40 under 40 in the waste industry



The biggest vaccination campaign in history has begun. More than **42.2 million doses** in 51 countries have been administered, according to data collected by Bloomberg.

The latest rate was roughly **2.43 million doses a day**, on average.

Vaccinations in the U.S. began Dec. 14 with health-care workers, and so far

14.3 million shots

have been given, according to a state-by-state tally by Bloomberg and data from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. In the last week, an average of **898,410 doses per day** were administered.

Vaccines Across America

Across the U.S., 4.4 doses have been administered for every 100 people, and 46% of the shots distributed to states have been administered

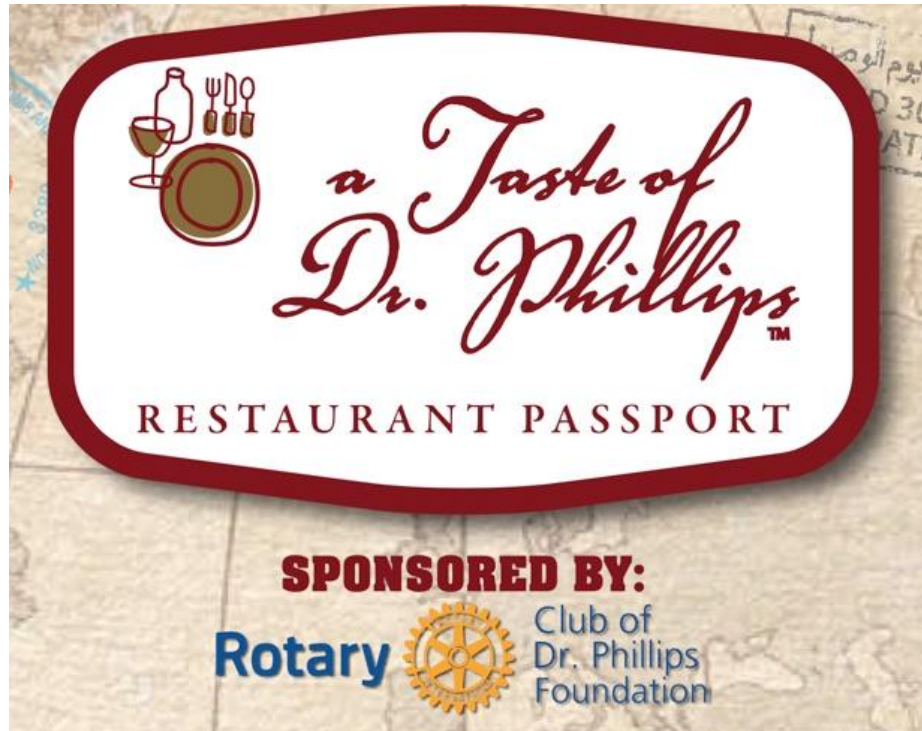
