

# Darrell Gardner

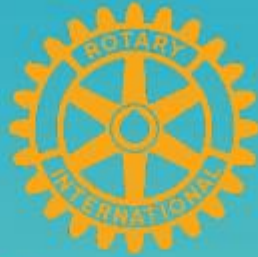
## Darrell Lee Gardner "Slugo"
