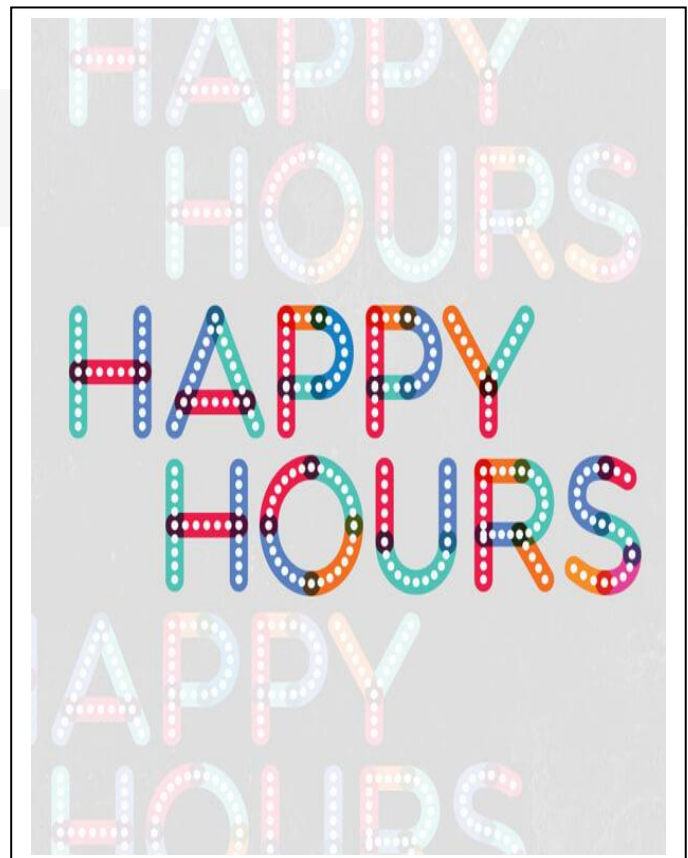



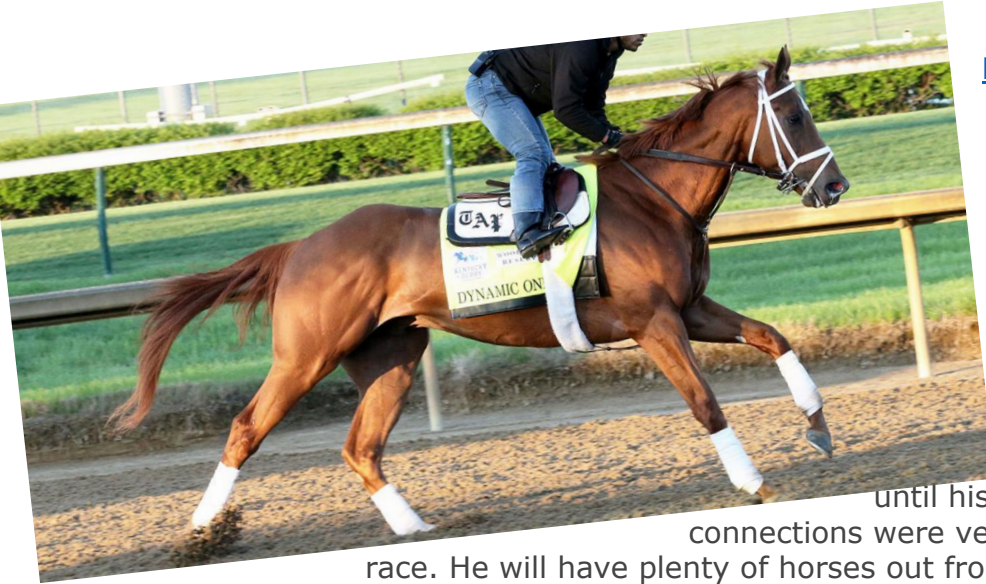

Dynamic One (30-1 – 40 – 2nd Wood Memorial (G2), 89 - Union Rags – Jose Ortiz /Todd Pletcher - 5: 1-2-0 - \$194,120) Dynamic One is the third Pletcher runner in the field, and this guy was handled with plenty of patience by his trainer. He faced tough fields in his early maiden races. In his fourth try at Aqueduct, he got what is currently his only win. In the Wood Memorial, he made a closing move, took the lead in the stretch and looked like a winner

until his stablemate caught him at the wire. The connections were very high on this horse heading into his last race. He will have plenty of horses out front to set the table for his closing move. **Win contender.**
