

<u>Pfizer Inc</u> and BioNTech SE said Wednesday that real-world data from Israel suggests that their <u>Covid-19</u> vaccine is 94 percent effective in preventing <u>asymptomatic infections</u>, meaning the vaccine could significantly reduce transmission.

The companies also said the latest analysis of the Israeli data shows the vaccine was 97 percent effective in preventing symptomatic disease, severe disease and death. That is basically in line with the 95 percent efficacy Pfizer and BioNTech reported from the vaccine's late-stage clinical trial in December.

Polio Eradication

23 clubs in our district have giving a total of over \$11,552 to Polio Plus as of end of March, 2021. They have a combined goal to raise over \$16,150 to eradicate Polio which if reached will exceed last year's club contributions to Polio Plus. Great work clubs! Keep up the momentum!.
