Byron Sutton is the CEO of both World Trade Center Orlando and Kissimmee Popcorn Company. He is retired from Northwest Airlines and the US Air Force, where he became a decorated hero in Viet Nam. He flew 1170 combat sorties in one year and has over 45,000 flying hours in everything from the T38 to the 747. He has been a Rotarian forever – meaning over 50 years! He has been involved in so many service projects for both the Windermere club and the District he cannot remember them all. Byron had the idea for both the back porch on the Town Hall and now for this new Pavilion project.



[The biggest vaccination campaign](#) in history is underway. More than **1.45 billion doses** have been administered across 176 countries, according to data collected by Bloomberg. The latest rate was roughly **23.7 million doses a day**.
