

SARS-CoV-2 Variants

Variants of viruses occur when there is a change — or mutation — to the virus's genes. Stuart Ray, M.D. says it is the nature of RNA viruses such as the coronavirus to evolve and change gradually. "Geographic separation tends to result in genetically distinct variants," he says. Mutations in viruses — including the coronavirus causing the COVID-19 pandemic — are neither new nor unexpected. "All RNA viruses mutate over time, some more than others. For example, flu viruses change often, which is why doctors recommend that you get a new flu vaccine every year."

- CDC Director Dr. Rochelle Walensky <u>endorsed recommendations</u> for booster doses for the Moderna and Johnson & Johnson vaccines, opening the way for millions more Americans to get booster shots.
- Walensky also endorsed the mix-and-match approach to boosters, saying eligible people could choose whichever vaccine they wished as a booster.
- Vaccine advisers to the FDA are scheduled to <u>meet next week</u> to consider Pfizer's request to authorize its vaccine to children ages 5 to 11.

19 - A BRIEF ROTARY HISTORY

The world's first service club, the Rotary Club of Chicago, Illinois, USA, was formed on 23 February 1905 by Paul P. Harris, an attorney who wished to recapture in a professional club the same friendly spirit he had felt in the small towns of his youth. The name "Rotary" derived from the early practice of rotating meetings among members' offices.

Rotary's popularity spread throughout the United States in the decade that followed; clubs were chartered from San Francisco to New York. By 1921, Rotary clubs had been formed on six continents, and the organization adopted the name Rotary International a year later.

As Rotary grew, its mission expanded beyond serving the professional and social interests of club members. Rotarians began pooling their resources and contributing their talents to help serve communities in need. The organization's dedication to this ideal is best expressed in its principal motto: Service Above Self. Rotary also later embraced a code of ethics, called The 4-Way Test, that has been translated into hundreds of languages.


