

#### LATEST NEWS (WebMD)

Nov. 26, 2021 -- The World Health Organization on Friday classified a new COVID-19 variant from South Africa as a "variant of concern," which means it could be more contagious, cause more severe disease and reduce the efficacy of <u>vaccines</u> and treatments. Omicron has some concerning properties. This variant has a large number of mutations, and some of these mutations have some worrying characteristics," Maria Van Kerkhove, the WHO's technical lead on the <u>coronavirus</u> pandemic, said in a video statement.

<sup>&</sup>quot;Preliminary evidence suggests an increased risk of reinfection with this variant, as compared to other [variants of concern]," the WHO said in a statement. "The number of cases of this variant appears to be increasing in almost all provinces in South Africa."

#### **Latest News**

Data from small clinical trials show that vaccine effectiveness against COVID-19 infection is waning after the primary series, but protection remains high against severe disease and hospitalization. Clinical trial data show a booster shot of Pfizer-BioNTech's COVID-19 vaccine is effective in protecting against COVID-19, adding to other evidence demonstrating that a booster shot may result in increased effectiveness compared to primary vaccination.
