MESSAGE FROM OUR PRESIDENT



Greetings Windermere Rotary Family It is my pleasure to serve as your 2021-2022 President.

We continue "World Understanding" month with recognition of Rotary's many international projects for peace and understanding. February is special in the Rotary calendar as it includes the anniversary of the first meeting of Rotary on February 23, 1905, now designated as World Understanding and Peace Day. Rotary's 100 plus years of promoting global understanding and peace has benefitted hundreds of thousands of people around the world.

We can be proud of our own club's outreach, organized by Emerson Greco, our Chairman for International Service, to partner with his previous club in Brazil in their efforts to care for the children of the San Jose Children's Home. Emerson joined the Rotary Club Nova Andradina in 2004 and was Club President in 2007-2008. They have been a continuing supporter of the San Jose Children's Home and the local cancer hospital, and they provide wheelchairs, walkers, and cold weather clothing for the needy in their area. Rotary Club Nova Andradina was founded in 1984 and is a medium-sized club like ours. Emerson joined our club in 2018 after he, his wife Edilaine, and their two sons Arthur and Rafael moved to Windermere.

Emerson received word that his club in Brazil finalized the project funded with our recent donations. They made needed repairs to the kitchen, and bought a washing machine, a stove, milk and diapers.

The San Jose Children's Home is similar in some ways to the Edgewood Children's Ranch. It is a non-profit entity founded in 1996 and financed by public resources mainly from contributions such as ours. The home shelters provisionally children/adolescents away from the family nucleus in a family home environment, and with protective shelter measures. The institution supplies basic needs for housing, food, clothing, access to health, education, sports and leisure. It provides for cases of abandonment, negligence, risk, or when families or guardians are temporarily unable to exercise their role of care and protection, until the return to living with the biological family is provided or, if this it is not possible, the referral to a substitute family. The goal is reintegration into the extended family of origin, or insertion into a substitute family, and preparation for detachment and integration into society. It can provide for up to 30 children, but averages around 20.

I look forward to maintaining and growing our friendship and partnership with the club in Brazil. Thanks to Emerson for making it happen.



Developing vaccines is now faster and easier than ever before because of mRNA platforms, which can be tailored to attack specific viruses in a matter of days or even hours. Sarah Fortune, John LaPorte Given Professor of Immunology and Infectious Diseases and chair of the Diseases, was quoted from Harvard Chan School's "Better Off" podcast. She said that mRNA vaccines are safer than vaccines that use small amounts of a live virus. She also noted that researchers had been working on mRNA platforms for decades, which is why manufacturers were able to produce vaccines so quickly after SARS-CoV-2 appeared.

Immunity gained through vaccination or infection with Omicron is expected to bring us closer to the end of the pandemic, although the journey may be rocky at times, according to experts. Even if the next variant is generally mild, like Omicron, if it's highly contagious it could still overwhelm the health care system. "When you've got something as transmissible as Omicron, you don't need it to be incredibly severe to really screw things up," said William Hanage, associate professor of epidemiology.

31 - INTERNATIONAL CONVENTIONS

Each May or June, Rotary International holds a worldwide convention "to stimulate, inspire and inform all Rotarians at an international level." The convention, which may not be held in the same country for more than two consecutive years, is the annual meeting to conduct the business of the association. The planning process usually begins about four or five years in advance.

The RI board determines a general location and invites cities to make proposals. The conventions are truly international events which 20,000 to 40,000 Rotarians and guests attend. All members should plan to participate in a Rotary International convention to discover the real internationality of Rotary. It is an experience you'll never forget.

From DG Barry:

I am very pleased that the RI Board of Directors has confirmed than the Houston International Convention will be LIVE this year from June 4th - June 8th! Registrations to date have been held back due to uncertainty created by COVID and whether or not the convention will be live. By making this announcement it is expected that people will be now step up registrations and to further encourage that, the Convention Committee has announced that the "early-bird" registration of \$495 per person for those who register prior to December 16th will be honored through February 28th! For those who registered after December 16th, their registration costs above the \$495 per person will be refunded automatically without any action necessary by the registrants.

D6980 is a short two-hour flight away and I strongly encourage everyone who can attend to do so. If you've attended a prior International Convention, you know that these conventions elevate your understanding of the power of Rotary worldwide. If you haven't attended before, you will strengthen your roots in Rotary more than you can imagine.
