- Countries are beginning to offer a fourth dose of the Covid-19 vaccine to vulnerable groups, but medical professionals are undecided on whether it would benefit the wider population.
- Questions are being raised over the need for more booster shots as the emergence of more Covid variants may require more targeted vaccines.
- The World Health Organization hasn't given an official recommendation on a fourth dose, and "there isn't any good evidence at this point of time," said WHO chief scientist Soumya Swaminathan.

Latest News (ABC News)

There are three COVID-19 vaccines approved for use in the U.S. The Pfizer, Moderna, and Johnson & Johnson vaccines are all highly effective in protecting you from the virus that causes COVID-19.

The CDC says there's a preference for the mRNA (Pfizer and Moderna) COVID-19 vaccines over the Johnson & Johnson vaccine. This is based on data from the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP). It discussed vaccine safety, vaccine effectiveness, rare negative side effects, and U.S. vaccine supply.

It's best to get a booster shot from either Pfizer or Moderna, but any booster is better than none. If you only have access to the Johnson & Johnson booster, you should still get it. The Pfizer vaccine received full FDA approval on Aug. 23 and is no longer under emergency use authorization (EUA). It will now be marketed under the name Comirnaty. Two other vaccines, from Novavax from AstraZeneca, are not available in the U.S.

Vaccines continue to lower your risk for severe disease, hospitalization, and death, even against the widespread Delta variant of COVID-19
