Frank is a Pennsylvania farm boy turned rocket guy. He graduated with a BS in Aerospace Engineering from Pennsylvania State University - founded in 1855 as a Farmers' high school. His career in aerospace spanned 45 years - first at the Naval Surface Weapons Center in Dahlgren, Virginia, then at Martin Marietta and Coleman Aerospace in Orlando. He did missile design, flight simulation, wind tunnel and flight testing, project management, subcontracts management, and business development. Frank worked with some success on antitank missiles, guided artillery projectiles, ballistic missiles, and space-launch systems, but he failed at maglev train development. Early in his career, while at Martin Marietta in Orlando, he was the trajectory guy on a concept study for what eventually became the Javelin topattack anti-tank missile (Ask him about the DARPA spec.). During his career, Frank got to know several astronauts and other high-ranking / famous people and even got to meet, and be insulted by, Elon Musk at his SpaceX factory in Hawthorne, CA.

Frank serves on two Town of Windermere volunteer committees - Tree Board, and Long-Range Planning. He lives on a dirt road and likes it that way.

The government will end its giveaway of Covid-19 at-home tests Friday because of insufficient congressional funding, a senior Biden administration official said Sunday.

A stockpile of the tests is being depleted, and officials want to have enough on hand in the event of a fall surge, the source said.

The giveaway, which includes tests mailed at no cost to recipients who request them at <u>Covidtests.gov</u>, will end Friday, according to an announcement on the site — unless there's a surprise round of funding from Congress, the source said.

"If Congress provides funding, we will expeditiously resume distribution of free tests through covidtests.gov," the source said. "Until then, we believe reserving the remaining tests for distribution later this year is the best course."

Latest News (US News)

While BA.5 has started to level off, another omicron subvariant called BA.4.6 has shown a slight increase, going from about 4% of cases at the end of July to 7% of infections as of this week. It remains unclear if this moderate increase will continue or if the strain can compete with BA.5.

The plateau of BA.5 is perhaps not surprising given that the latest COVID-19 wave in the U.S. <u>has peaked</u> and is on the decline. The U.S. is averaging about 90,000 new cases a day, which is down from nearly 130,000 a day one month ago. Hospitalizations and deaths are also showing slight declines.

The trends are mirrored in other countries.

According to the World Health Organization, the number of new weekly cases reported globally decreased 9% last week over the previous week. The number of new weekly deaths also decreased by 15%.

But the prevalence of BA.5 is actually increasing globally, going from 71% in late July to 74% by mid-August.

Still, a glimmer of hope could be on the horizon. Both <u>Moderna</u> and <u>Pfizer</u> this week asked the Food and Drug Administration to authorize their updated COVID-19 booster shots that are designed specifically to take on BA.4 and BA.5. The Biden administration has pushed these shots as having the potential to protect against infection as well as against severe disease.

The FDA said it will not hold a meeting of its outside vaccine experts to discuss the applications "as the agency feels confident in the extensive discussion that was held in June," FDA Commissioner Robert Califf tweeted.






