The Covid pandemic may be nearing a close, the World Health Organization said Wednesday. New weekly deaths reached their lowest point last week since March 2020. The WHO recorded [around 11,000 deaths](#) globally the week of Sept. 5-11, a 22% decrease from the previous week.

New weekly cases also fell by 28% in that time, from nearly 4.2 million during the week of Aug. 29 to Sept. 4 to around 3.1 million last week, according to the WHO.

"We have never been in a better position to end the pandemic," WHO Director-General Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus said at a briefing Wednesday. "We are not there yet, but the end is in sight."

U.S. Covid deaths, however, have stayed relatively flat, with little change over the last two weeks, according to [NBC News' tally](#). The U.S. is recording a weekly average of 478 Covid deaths a day, which is far above its lowest rate ever: 168 daily deaths the week that ended July, 6, 2021. In June 2022, the average was 258 daily deaths.

Sep. 24, 2022 -- Americans are not rushing to receive the updated COVID-19 booster vaccine.

The newest booster became available to the public around Labor Day weekend and about 4.4 million people have gotten it as of Sept. 21, according to [CDC data](#). That figure represents about 1.5% of the people eligible to receive the booster, [NBC News](#) reported.

The White House has said the total is probably closer to 5 million people. The CDC totals don't yet include Texas and Idaho, which use an aggregate vaccination record reporting method for the Pfizer vaccine.

Scott Roberts, MD, a Yale Medicine infectious disease specialist, told NBC News the low numbers are "demoralizing."

"I would expect a much higher proportion of Americans to have gotten the booster by this point," he said. "The fact that this booster came out days before Biden said the pandemic is over is a huge mixed message. Now it's going to be that much harder to convince those at risk who are on the fence to get a booster."

White House COVID-19 coordinator Ashish Jha, MD, says he thinks demand will pick up in the coming weeks.

"We've been thinking and talking about this as an annual vaccine like the flu vaccine. Flu vaccine season picks up in late September and early October. We're just getting our education campaign going. So we expect to see, despite the fact that this was a strong start, we actually expect this to ramp up stronger," Jha said.

The new booster is the third one authorized by the federal government and was redesigned to protect against the currently circulating subvariants BA.4 and BA.5 of the Omicron strain. People who have received a primary vaccine series or a booster at least 2 months before can receive it.

The new Pfizer booster is available for people 12 and up and the Moderna version for people 18 and up. The vaccines can be mixed and matched.

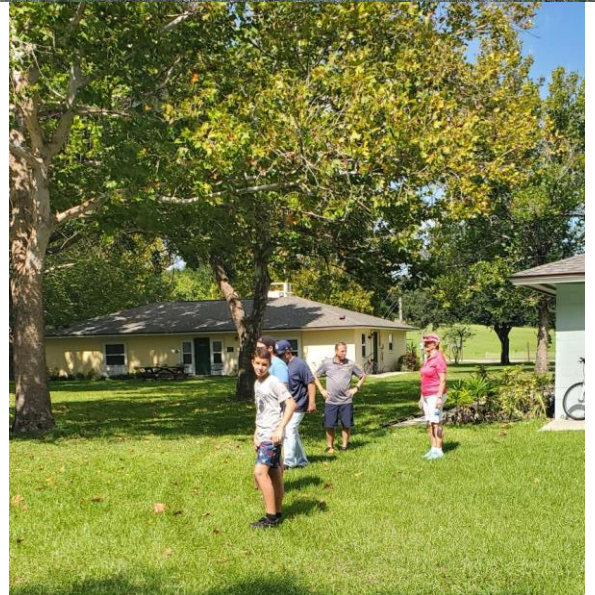

Windermere Saturday night**



The blast-off was the fourth launch and landing for the private, Elon Musk-founded company's Falcon 9 first stage booster, which SpaceX dubbed as "the world's first orbital class reusable rocket."

Reusability, according to SpaceX, allows the most expensive parts of the rocket to be reused, driving down the cost of space access in the process.

The rocket started its descent nine minutes after its launch on Saturday.
