What Is Rotary?

Rotary International is a service organization with 1.2 million members in 33,000 clubs in over 200 countries. Rotary is a diverse organization, apolitical, nonsectarian, and open to all faiths. A Rotary Club's membership is representative of the community it serves. As a global network, we strive to build a world where people unite and take actions to create lasting change. Rotary values diversity and celebrates the contributions of people of all backgrounds, regardless of their age, ethnicity, race, color, abilities, religion, socioeconomic status, culture, sex, sexual orientation, and gender identity.

What Is the Rotary Club of Windermere?

The Rotary Club of Windermere was chartered in 1969. When you join our club, you become part of a prestigious group of leaders in the Central Florida community. Located in the heart of Windermere at Town Hall, our club boasts a membership of nearly 50 active members. Through weekly meetings and club committee involvement, you will gain lifelong friendships that you would not acquire otherwise. It is truly a club of fellowship, community, and business connections like no other.

What Are My Commitments to Rotary?

Club members assume personal and financial obligations including dues, meals and involvement in club projects. A Rotary club's primary purpose is to provide service to the local community through donations of time, talent, and treasure. Fellowship and Business Connections

Rotary membership has a certain prestige. You meet many of the community's present and upcoming leaders. There are opportunities to network, socialize and develop business relationships with other club members. However, expecting to solicit business from other members should not be motivation for joining Rotary. Members should refrain from networking for business purposes during club meetings. When we focus on Rotary activities, business opportunities often appear at the most unexpected times.

Attendance

Rotary International encourages regular meeting attendance. Our club targets attendance of at least 50% of the weekly meetings. You are also encouraged to attend a meeting at any Rotary club anywhere in the world or online at http://rotaryeclubone.org. Attending meetings in other local clubs, other states, or other countries is a highlight of being a Rotarian. When you walk into another club's meeting, you are instantly surrounded and welcomed warmly by new friends.

Rotary Club of Windermere Meetings

Rotary Club of Windermere meetings are normally held every Tuesday except holidays. On the 4th Monday of the month, we have an informal social at 6 pm. Tuesday meetings start at about 6:45 AM, with time to network, socialize, and have breakfast followed by a presentation of interest to members, and adjournment at 8:00 AM. The Rotary Satellite Club meets on pre-announced Thursdays at 11:30 AM at Health Central Hospital. As a courtesy to our speakers, you are expected to remain until the meeting is adjourned. If you must leave earlier, please do so before the speaker begins.

Family Membership

Family Membership is encouraged. The family unit can be both spouses or one spouse and a young adult living at home.

Corporate Membership

The Rotary Club of Windermere invites corporations to join. The corporation may appoint up to three persons to be its designees, one of whom must be a member of that entity's local management group; the others must be employed by the corporation. Each designee will be listed as an active member of the club and it will be noted in the roster that they are designees of the corporation. If the designee of the eligible corporation is no longer an employee of the corporate members may have their logo prominently shown on the club website, and will receive discounts for sponsorships of club events, as determined by the Board.

eMembership

A Rotarian who cannot attend meetings regularly but wants to be active may join as an eMember or convert their regular individual membership to an eMembership. This membership allows the member to participate in all service or fundraising projects but recognizes their inability to regularly attend meetings. eMembers may not be club officers or board members.

Honorary Membership

The Rotary Club of Windermere grants Honorary membership to select officials and major contributors to the community.
