NOTE FROM NORMA FOR YOUR INFORMATION:

We have some opposition to the pavilion. A letter has been circulated asking the question why we need this – that just because someone offers to give it to you doesn't mean we have to accept. This individual supports the local businesses but not the Rotary Club and doesn't believe we should have a concession stand. Even though it will be available to all Town committees for their events and to renters if the Town chooses to rent it, this individual is adamantly opposed to it. It will not compete with the businesses very often, but again, when that happens, it is for charity - not for profit. We need a place to provide hamburgers and hot dogs for Veterans and popcorn and drinks for kids during afternoon and evening events. After all that this club has done for this town, it doesn't seem asking for much.

In addition, for Food Truck nights and other events, the Town will no longer have to rent toilets or lights. It is hoped that we will be able to put solar panels on the slanted roof that will provide more electricity than the building will require. The stage will be a beautiful addition and many events can be held there for awards, presentations, contests, dances, concerts, and so on. We tore down the eyesore old building. Why there is any negative attached to this is surprising but then again, it is Windermere.

I bring this up because it is important that you hear for yourself on the workshop call so that you can defend and support our project, which is for the greater good!
