As you may be aware, the Town has been working alongside the Rotary Club of Windermere and Healthy West Orange to develop an outdoor pavilion at the northwest corner of Town Square Park. The Town Council is scheduled to discuss this project at their February 28, 2023 workshop. The plans are currently at 45% and can be reviewed, along with other related documents, <u>here.</u>

Town staff would like to invite you to a Virtual Public Input Workshop, prior to the February Council Workshop, in order to answer any questions, address concerns, and further discuss the proposed project. In order to do so most effectively, we are inviting you to a Zoom workshop with Town Staff and consultants on Monday, January 23, 2023 at 6:00 pm.

NOTE FROM NORMA FOR YOUR INFORMATION:

- 1. We have a contract with the Town and the West Orange Healthcare District to build the pavilion.
- 2. The Council approved the initial design already.
- 3. We have already spent considerable monies on architects and construction.
- 4. We demolished the old community building and are prepared to take down trees.
- 5. The basketball courts are not affected and are a distance from the stage.
- 6. We must complete the construction by June 2024.
- 7. The concession stand is for both the Rotary Club to use at its events and the Town to use or rent at their discretion.
- 8. Rotary's purpose is to prepare hamburgers & hot dogs, sell popcorn, candy and soft drinks at events, raise money for our charitable projects.
- 9. We often purchase products form the Town businesses for our events.
- 10. Concessions stand is no more competition than the tents we set up during events.
- 11. The stage is new benefit, which is designed to seat a 50 piece orchestra, which event we recently saw where a tent had to be rented and set up.
- 12. The restrooms are bigger and better and negates the need to rent portable potties.
- 13. The drop-down screen is for movie nights and negates renting a screen.
- 14. The lighting package will replace the need to rent lights at food truck night.
- 15. There is always a handful of people who are critical of any improvements in town.


