# **GUEST SPEAKER OF THE DAY**



Chief David A. Ogden has been a successful law enforcement executive with over 35 years in policing and a BA degree in criminal justice. The Chief of Police in Windermere for nine years, he has led a successful transformation in the agency. As a former Director of the Central Florida Intelligence Exchange and a Captain for the Sheriff's Office Intelligence Unit, he was responsible for domestic homeland security, intelligence sharing and collaboration for local, state, federal and private sector partnerships. Chief Ogden also commanded the west side Sector III Patrol Section with proven crime reduction utilizing the Intelligence Led Policing model for success. He served in other notable areas of policing including 14 years on the SWAT team. Chief Ogden is a strong believer in the team concept and the importance of good leadership.

Chief Ogden has developed a deep appreciation for the spirit of volunteerism in our local community and its importance to the law enforcement profession. He currently sits on several local nonprofit charities to include; the Roper YMCA Board, NFL Alumni Association of Central Florida, the Wounded Officer Imitative Advisory Board and the Windermere Police Department Foundation, Inc. which was established in honor of Windermere Police Officer Robert German who was killed in the line of duty on March 22, 2014. Most recently he celebrates the accreditation received after years of hard work and preparation.

Dave is married with four children. His family is the founder of a local charity in honor of one of his children who lost a battle from a rare neurological disease. The Ogden family is active with local and national organizations, raising awareness, support and medical research to help find a cure for children and families who struggle with similar issues or special needs. His favorite quote is "leadership is service, not your position".


